

## English

We are going to be looking at fables with hidden morals including Greek Myths and legends (Heracles' 12 Quests), where we will then create our own versions building upon previous English skills. We will be exploring argument (balanced with both sides of the argument) and persuasion linking to Athens vs Sparta.

## Theme

Children will be investigating what it was like to live in Ancient Greece including looking at culture and society as a whole. We will be researching philosophy, finding out about Greek thinkers. Also, we will see what it was like during the first Olympic Games and look at the similarities and differences of Greek cities including Athens and Sparta.

## Maths

The children will be developing their understanding and skills in mental and written calculations including problem solving in real life situations. Oral reasoning and collaborative activities will be crucial in our Maths learning. Year 6 children will be preparing for their SATs which start the week beginning 14/05/18.

## Science

In our science this term we are going to learn about keeping healthy. Children will be able to recognise different types of foods and how they affect the body. Also, we will look at the circulatory system of animals and human, this will be underpinned by the children taking part in a heart and lung dissection.

## Design and Technology

This term we will be looking at food technology linking in with our Healthy Eating in Science. The children will have the opportunity to taste some traditional Greek dishes and even plan and create some of their own.

## Religious Education

This term we will be learning about Sikhism, to do this we will interpret information from a range of sources. We will be focusing on who Sikhs worship and how they practice their religion.

## Art

We will be exploring art using different mediums e.g. modelling, Paper Mache, ICT and sketching to develop our skills. We will link it into our theme by researching and making Greek detailed shields.

## Primary Modern Languages

This term, in their French learning the children will continue to develop their confidence with conversation skills and build on their previous learning with numbers, colours, gestures and greetings.

## Physical Education

In dance we will be learning a range of new dance movements to build up to producing a routine linked to Ancient Greece, which we hope to share. The children will also be learning more about invasion games. They will be building upon their running, passing, and invasion techniques to understand how stamina and power help people to perform well in different activities (making links to our 'being healthy' Science theme).

## Computing

The children will be using Scratch, a control program that will enable them to create their own interactive stories, animations, games, music, and art. The children will be mixing different types of media clips (graphics, photos, music, sounds) in creative ways to create their own apps, which will continue throughout the year.
